Mark Myers, M.D. is a neuroradiologist at Center for Diagnostic Imaging (CDI), bringing 15 years of experience in imaging and interventional procedures. Dr. Myers is actively involved in neuroradiological imaging, spine imaging and intervention, and is directing our spinal augmentation practice and advanced spine investigations at CDI.

Dr. Myers has unique, specialized expertise in MR and CT angiography for brain applications, having treated more than 1,000 intracranial aneurysms. He also has additional expertise in vertebroplasty (spinal augmentation) procedures. Dr. Myers has treated more than 1,750 patients with spinal fractures using this technique.

Dr. Myers completed a fellowship in neuroradiology from the University of Minnesota and a residency in diagnostic radiology at St. Luke's Hospital of Kansas City in Missouri. He received his doctor of medicine and bachelor of science degrees from the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis, Minnesota. He also attended Oxford University in England while an undergraduate.
